Board Member Responsibilities

1. Serves a minimum of one (1) two year term on the Board.
2. Attend at least 75% of board meetings per year.
3. Each member of the Board of Directors shall contribute at least one thousand cash dollars (\$1,000) to the organization annually, all or part of which may come from the tax deductible value paid for or solicited by the Board member, and received by the Lambda Pi Chi Foundation.
4. Makes a serious commitment to participate actively in Foundation work and events.
5. Stays informed about Foundation matters, is prepared for meetings, and reviews and comments on minutes and reports.
6. Builds a collegial working relationship with other board members that contributes to consensus.
7. Participates in the board's annual evaluation and planning efforts.
8. Participates in the advancement of the strategic plan of the Foundation including fundraising and committee member recruitment.
